CABLE SYSTEM DESIGN AND CAPACITY

Non-common carrier fiber-optic submarine cable system connecting the United States, Bermuda, the Azores, and Spain. Transatlantic Segment: approx. 7,620 km. Bermuda Segment: approx. 211 km. Azores Segment: approx. 322 km. Each segment has 16 fiber pairs at approximately 24.5 Tbps design capacity per pair.

OWNERSHIP OF THE CABLE SYSTEM

All entities are indirect wholly owned subsidiaries of Google LLC: Starfish Infrastructure Inc. (U.S. territory); Sea Fan Singapore Infrastructure Pte. Ltd. (international waters); Skipjack Infrastructure Limited (Bermuda); Sailfish Infrastructure Unipessoal LDA (Portugal); Cardinal Fish Infrastructure S.L. (Spain).

OWNERSHIP OF LANDING STATIONS

(1) FLAGLER COUNTY, FLORIDA: Tarpon Services LLC, a U.S. entity and indirect wholly owned Google LLC subsidiary, will construct and own the cable landing station. Starfish (Google) will be the U.S. landing party and control the cable landing station.

(2) Annie's Bay, Bermuda: Sea Grass Services Limited (Google subsidiary) constructs/owns; Skipjack controls.

(3) Sao Miguel, Azores: Angler Fish Services Unipessoal LDA (Google subsidiary) constructs/owns; Sailfish controls.

(4) Cantabria Region, Spain: Lanternfish Services S.L. (Google subsidiary) constructs/owns; Cardinal Fish controls.

WAIVER REQUEST -- SECTION 1.767(h)(1)

Starfish requests a waiver so that Tarpon Services LLC is not required to be a co-applicant. Tarpon will provide limited colocation space and operation/maintenance services at Starfish's direction. Tarpon will not have independent ability to affect Sol system operation. Agreement with Tarpon has an initial term of 25 years.

GOOGLE CORPORATE CHAIN

Starfish > Sea Coral Holdings LLC > Google LLC > XXVI Holdings Inc. > Alphabet Inc. Larry Page holds 26.8% voting interest; Sergey Brin holds 25% voting interest. Alphabet publicly traded on NASDAQ.

KEY INVESTIGATIVE TIMELINE (PalmCoastStorylines.com)

Oct 2024: Flagler Beach easement approved -- BEFORE FCC license application was filed.

Sep 10, 2025: FCC application filed. License not yet granted.

Oct 21, 2025: Palm Coast development order issued -- after application filed, before any grant.

Nov 19, 2025: Mark Fumia (Google, 1600 Amphitheatre Pkwy, Mountain View CA) signs FPL underground easement for Tarpon Services parcel (OR Book 3010 PG 228, Flagler County).

Feb 13, 2026: FCC public notice issues -- application still in 45-day streamlined review. No license granted as of this date.

Apr 8, 2026: Palm Coast building permit issued. Construction underway. FCC license status as of publication date unknown.
